Sauro Filippeschi earned his M.S. degrees in Mechanical Engineering and his PhD diploma in Energetics at University of Pisa in 1997 and 2001, respectively. He published, 67 journal articles and 110 conference articles/abstracts. Actually, he is Associate Professor in Thermodynamics and Heat Transfer at University of Pisa. He has been scientific responsible of the 9 international research projects mainly supported by the European Space Agency and by the Air Force Laboratory (USA). He is Vice-President of the School of Engineering at University of Pisa. He has given 3 plenaries, keynote and invited lectures. He was invited as Visiting Researcher at the Trinity College of Dublin. His main research topics are basically on the field of two-phase heat transfer and it focuses on the heat pipe devices both for ground and space applications. He is member of the International Heat Pipe Scientific Committee from 2020.
